In July, 2013, Claudia Israel took the image to Swanlund's Camera in Eureka, CA. and discussed options with processor. Made arrangements for him to flatten image for a one time copy to be made and sent to an out of the area for digital restoration. Restored image is on a disk. An 8"x10" print was made and framed and is [in 2014] on display at Phillips House Museum
